HOUSE BILL 1355

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-15-1202 RELATING TO
9 SPECIAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR RETIRED MILITARY
10 PERSONNEL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "SPECIAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR RETIRED MILITARY
14 PERSONNEL."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-15-1202 is amended to read as follows:
19 "27-15-1202. Eligibility and issuance of plates.

20 (a) Upon application, accompanied by proof of retirement from one (1)
21 of the following services of the armed forces of the United States, upon
22 complying with the state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and
23 licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the regular license fee for
24 license plates as prescribed by law, plus *five dollars (\$5.00) to be deposited*
25 *to the State Central Services Fund Account as direct revenues of the Department*
26 *of Finance and Administration* for each special license plate *issued or renewed*
27 each owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of Arkansas and
28 who is a retired member of the United States Army, United States Navy, or
29 United States Marine Corps, United States Air Force, United States Coast
30 Guard, or National Guard shall be issued a special license plate or plates
31 described in § 27-15-1203 for his private motor vehicle or vehicles, used for
32 his personal conveyance and not for commercial purposes.

33 (b) No more than two (2) license plates shall be issued to any such
34 owner, and the plates shall be nontransferable.

35 (c) All applications for these license plates shall be made to the

1 Director of the Department of Finance and Administration.

2 (d) For purposes of determining retirement status, the director shall
3 accept a copy of the retirement orders issued by the armed services."

4

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.

14

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
