**HOUSE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION  
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION  
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
20 established for the Soil and Water Conservation Commission - State Operations  
21 for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees  
22 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
23 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its  
24 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
25 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
26 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
27 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
28 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
29 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

7           SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
8 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

10 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

26           SECTION 31. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
27 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the

30           SECTION 32. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
31 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
32 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
33 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
34 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

1           SECTION 33. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
2 with this Act are hereby repealed.

4           SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
5 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
6 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
7 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
