# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE JUSTICE BUILDING COMMISSION AND  
9 TRANSFER ITS POWERS AND DUTIES TO STATE BUILDING SERVICES;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "TO ABOLISH THE JUSTICE BUILDING COMMISSION AND TRANSFER  
14 ITS POWERS AND DUTIES TO STATE BUILDING SERVICES."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. The Justice Building Commission created by Arkansas Code 22-  
19 3-904 is hereby abolished and all of its powers, duties, functions, records,  
20 personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or  
21 other funds are hereby transferred to the Arkansas State Building Services  
22 created by Arkansas Code 22-2-104.

24 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
25 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
26 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
32 act are declared to be severable.

34 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
35 hereby repealed.

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SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that State Building Services should perform the duties of the Justice Building Commission; that this act abolishes the Justice Building Commission and transfers its powers and duties to State Building Services; that such transfer should occur at the beginning of the next fiscal year; and that unless this emergency clause is adopted this act will not go into effect until after the beginning of the next fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
