**HOUSE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-15-102 (b) TO PROVIDE  
9 THAT COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICERS WHO QUALIFY AS LAW  
10 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF\_S  
11 OFFICE AND UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE COUNTY SHERIFF;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICERS WHO QUALIFY AS LAW  
15 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE  
16 COUNTY SHERIFF."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-15-102(b) is amended to read as follows:

22 "(b) The environmental officer may complete the training course for law  
23 enforcement officers at the Law Enforcement Training Academy. After  
24 satisfactory completion of said course the environmental officer shall be a  
25 law enforcement officer and shall be a part of the sheriff\_s department and  
26 under the supervision and direction of the county sheriff."  
27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
