HOUSE BILL 1541

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR LAND ACQUISITION,
9 CONSTRUCTION AND RELATED EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 HEALTH WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO
11 THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 253 OF 1991, FOR THE
12 REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Department of Health, to be payable from the State Health Building and Local
23 Grant Trust Fund, for land and building acquisition, construction, expansion
24 and related expenses of the Department of Health which shall be supplemental
25 and in addition to those funds appropriated in Act 253 of 1991, for the
26 remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

32 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided
31 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of
32 Health are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department
33 of Health to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
34 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of
35 Health to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of

1 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
2 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
3 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
4 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
5 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
