HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 6-53-403 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL BOARD OF A TECHNICAL COLLEGE SHALL
10 BECOME MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL BOARD OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE
11 FOLLOWING A CONVERSION OF THE TECHNICAL COLLEGE TO A
12 COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "TECHNICAL COLLEGE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL BECOME BOARD
15 MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AFTER CONVERSION TO A
16 COMMUNITY COLLEGE."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-53-403(e)(1) is hereby amended to read as
22 follows:

23 "(e)(1) Following the conversion of a technical college to a community
24 college, the members of the local board of the technical college shall become
25 members of the community college board with two (2) additional board members
26 to be appointed by the Governor. The board shall then draw lots with three
27 (3) lots for two (2) year terms, three (3) lots for four (4) year terms, and
28 three (3) lots for six (6) year terms. All records, personnel, property,
29 unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of the
30 technical college shall be transferred to the local board of the community
31 college."

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
