HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE EXECUTIVE,
9 JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF THE STATE WHICH
10 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 7 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE
17 BRANCHES OF THE STATE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Auditor of State, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for
23 personal services of the various constitutional officers which shall be
24 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 7
25 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the
26 following:

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34 SECTION 2. Items (14), (15), and (19) of Act 7 of 1991 as amended by
35 Act 788 of 1991 are hereby amended to read as follows:

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10 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided
9 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Auditor of
10 State are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Auditor of
11 State to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
12 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Auditor of
13 State to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
14 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
15 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
16 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
18 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
