HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PERMIT CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES TO PURCHASE
9 CREDITED SERVICE IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT
10 SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "AN ACT TO PERMIT CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES TO PURCHASE
14 CREDITED SERVICE IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT
15 SYSTEM."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18
19 SECTION 1. Any member of the Public Employees Retirement System who
20 previously served as an elected city attorney of a city of the first class
21 covered by the Public Employees Retirement System shall be entitled to receive
22 up to six (6) years of credited service in the Public Employees Retirement
23 System, provided that:

24 (1) The member makes application to the Board of Directors of the
25 Public Employees Retirement System for such service and submits proof of the
26 service for which credit is applied; and

27 (2) The member pays, or causes to be paid, to the system, all employee
28 and employer contributions based on fees paid by the city to the member from
29 court costs as provided by law in lieu of salary while serving as an elected
30 city attorney which would have been paid to the system, plus interest thereon
31 at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum from the date such funds would have
32 been paid, to the date on which such contributions are actually paid pursuant
33 to the provisions of this act.

34
35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
