HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
10 EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
12 BY ACT 1058 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION. There is
22 hereby established for the Department of Education - Educational Television
23 Division - Early Childhood Education for the remainder of the 1991-93
24 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall be
25 supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act
26 1058 of 1991 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
28 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
29 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
30 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
31 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
32 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
33 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Early Childhood Education for the remainder of the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification, which such positions shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 4 of Act 1058 of 1991.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Early Childhood Education, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code §19-4-801 of the Department of Education - Educational Television Division, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Early Childhood Education which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 5 of Act 1058 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

10 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32
33 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided
9 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of
10 Education - Educational Television Division are, due to unforeseen
11 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Education - Educational
12 Television Division to continue to provide essential governmental services;
13 that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the
14 Department of Education - Educational Television Division to continue such
15 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
16 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
17 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
18 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
20 date of its passage and approval.
