For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-9-106(b) PERTAINING TO
9 THE POWERS OF THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT
10 STANDARDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-9-106(b) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(b) In addition to the requirements of subsection (a) of this section
21 and §12-9-104(7), the commission, by rules and regulations, shall fix such
22 other qualifications as it deems necessary. For purposes of this section, no
23 person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is found guilty of a felony
24 shall be appointed or certified by the commission as a law enforcement officer
25 notwithstanding that the conviction has been expunged or pardoned."

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.
