HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 14-52-107(c) TO
9 ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO BE PAID FOR SICK LEAVE
10 EQUIVALENT TO FOUR AND ONE-HALF (4 1/2) MONTHS SALARY AT
11 RETIREMENT OR DEATH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO BE PAID FOR SICK
15 LEAVE EQUIVALENT TO FOUR AND ONE-HALF (4 1/2) MONTHS
16 SALARY AT RETIREMENT OR DEATH."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §14-52-107(c) is hereby amended to
21 read as follows:

22 "(c) If, at the end of his term of service, upon retirement or death
23 whichever occurs first, any police officer has unused accumulated sick leave,
24 he shall be paid for this sick leave at the regular rate of pay in effect at
25 the time of retirement or death. Payment for unused sick leave in the case of
26 a police officer, upon retirement or death, shall not exceed three (3) months
27 salary unless the city, by ordinance, authorizes a greater amount, but in no
28 event to exceed four and one-half (4 1/2) months salary."

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
