## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO SELL OR GIVE  
9 CIGARETTES TO ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS  
10 OR TO BUY ANY CIGARETTES FOR ANY SUCH PERSON; TO PRESCRIBE  
11 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

15 "MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SELL OR GIVE CIGARETTES TO OR TO  
16 BUY CIGARETTES FOR A PERSON UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE."

17

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. It is unlawful for any person to sell or give any cigarette  
21 or cigarettes to or to buy any cigarette or cigarettes for any person under  
22 eighteen (18) years of age.

23

24 SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall upon  
25 conviction be subject to a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

26

27 SECTION 3. When any person is convicted of violating the provisions of  
28 this act, twenty percent (20%) of the fine collected shall be credited to the  
29 city general fund of the city in which the fine is assessed, and eighty  
30 percent (80%) thereof shall be deposited in the State Treasury as general  
31 revenues.

32

33 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
