For An Act To Be Entitled

11 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT UPON THE ARREST OF A JUVENILE IT
12 SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE JUVENILE INTAKE OFFICER
13 TO TRANSPORT THE JUVENILE TO THE APPROPRIATE FACILITY; AND
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

17 "UPON THE ARREST OF A JUVENILE IT SHALL BE THE
18 RESPONSIBILITY OF JUVENILE INTAKE OFFICER TO TRANSPORT
19 JUVENILE TO APPROPRIATE FACILITY."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22

23 SECTION 1. When any law enforcement agency notifies the appropriate
24 juvenile court intake officer that a minor has been taken into custody, it is
25 the responsibility and duty of the intake officer to transport the minor to
26 the appropriate juvenile facility. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of
27 the intake officer to provide transportation for the minor as long as the
28 minor is housed at a juvenile facility.

29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
