HOUSE BILL

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For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENTS ON REGULATIONS
8 THAT IMPOSE NEW OR ADDITIONAL COST OBLIGATIONS FOR
9 EDUCATION ON THE STATE OR LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS; TO
10 DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

12 "TO REQUIRE FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENTS ON REGULATIONS
13 IMPOSING NEW OR ADDITIONAL COST OBLIGATIONS FOR
14 EDUCATION."

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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18 SECTION 1. No regulation imposing a new or increased cost obligation
19 for education on the state or any local school district shall be valid unless,
20 thirty-five (35) days prior to its adoption by a board, commission, agency,
21 department, officer, or other authority of the government of the State of
22 Arkansas, excepting the General Assembly, the courts, and the Governor, the
23 board, commission, agency, department, officer, or other authority has filed a
24 fiscal impact statement with the Secretary of State and the Joint Interim
25 Committee on Education of the Arkansas General Assembly.

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27 SECTION 2. As used in this act, unless the context otherwise requires,
28 "fiscal impact statement" means a realistic statement of the purpose of a
29 proposed regulation promulgated under a law and the estimated financial cost
30 to the state or any local school district of implementing or complying with
31 the proposed regulation. The fiscal impact statement shall be developed with
32 the guidance and approval of the Office of Tax Research of the Bureau of
33 Legislative Research.

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2 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
3 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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6 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 act are declared to be severable.

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12 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13 hereby repealed.

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15 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
16 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly that the State of Arkansas and local school
17 districts face fiscal uncertainty as a result of having rules and regulations
18 imposed upon them without their knowledge of possible fiscal impact and that
19 such fiscal uncertainty can have adverse effects on the financial stability of
20 the State of Arkansas and local school districts and that the immediate
21 passage of this act is necessary to provide greater economic stability.
22 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being
23 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
25 approval.

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
