For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 21-8-604(2)(A) TO
9 ALLOW PAYMENT OF FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) FOR FOOD, LODGING
10 AND TRAVEL FOR SPOUSES OF PUBLIC SERVANTS BY LOBBYISTS;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO ALLOW PAYMENT OF \$50.00 FOR FOOD, LODGING AND TRAVEL
15 FOR SPOUSES OF PUBLIC SERVANTS BY LOBBYISTS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §21-8-604(2)(A) is amended to read
20 as follows:

21 "(2)(A) An itemized listing of the following expenditures made or gifts
22 given while engaged in the act of lobbying:

23 (i) Gift given to a public servant or the spouse of a
24 public servant, or on behalf of the public servant, or the spouse of the
25 public servant;

26 (ii) Payment for food, lodging, entertainment or travel in excess of
27 fifty dollars (\$50.00) on behalf of a public servant, or the spouse of a
28 public servant; and

29 (iii) Any other item paid or given to a public servant or the spouse of
30 a public servant or on behalf of the public servant or the spouse of a public
31 servant, except for campaign contributions, having a value in excess of fifty
32 dollars (\$50.00) unless consideration of equal or greater value has been given
33 therefor."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
