**HOUSE BILL 2009**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR VARIOUS NEW AND EXPANDED PROGRAMS  
10 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE FOR THE  
11 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF  
15 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - USED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER LICENSING  
21 PROGRAM. There is hereby established for the Department of Arkansas State  
22 Police for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular  
23 employees for the Department of Arkansas State Police, whose salaries shall be  
24 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
25 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
26 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
27 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
28 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
29 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of  
30 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
31 101), or its successor.

5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - USED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER LICENSING PROGRAM. There

6 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be

7 payable from the Arkansas State Police Fund, for personal services and

8 operating expenses of the Department of Arkansas State Police - Used Motor

9 Vehicle Dealer Licensing Program for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995,

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28 SECTION 3. REGULAR SALARIES - WEAPONS LICENSING PROGRAM. There is

29 hereby established for the Department of Arkansas State Police for the 1993-95

30 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees for the Department

31 of Arkansas State Police, whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions

32 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201

33 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,

34 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set

35 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform

1 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
2 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
3 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
4 successor.

14 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - WEAPONS LICENSING PROGRAM. There is hereby  
15 appropriated to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from  
16 the Arkansas State Police Fund, for personal services and operating expenses  
17 of the Department of Arkansas State Police - Weapons Licensing Program for the  
18 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

1 SECTION 5. SPECIAL REVENUE FUND CREATED. There is hereby created on  
2 the books of the State Treasurer, State Auditor and Chief Fiscal Officer of  
3 the State a Special Revenue fund to be known as the "Arkansas State Police  
4 Equipment Fund" which shall consist of fees collected for background  
5 investigations conducted by the Department of Arkansas State Police as may be  
6 authorized by law.

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8 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS. There is hereby  
9 appropriated to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from  
10 the Arkansas State Police Equipment Fund, for acquisition of an automated  
11 fingerprint identification system for the biennial period ending June 30,  
12 1995, the sum of..... \$2,000,000.

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14 SECTION 7. *The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police may,*  
15 *where circumstances warrant, request a special rate of compensation up to the*  
16 *maximum for the grade for the following classifications, based on prevailing*  
17 *wage rates for surrounding states:*

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22 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
23 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
24 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
25 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
28 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
29 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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32 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
34 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
35 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
2 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
3 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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6 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
7 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
8 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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10 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
11 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
12 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
13 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
14 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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16 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
17 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
18 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
19 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
24 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
