# **A Bill**

**HOUSE BILL**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO LIMIT REMEDIATION AND TUTORIAL SERVICES AT TWO  
9 YEAR AND FOUR YEAR POST SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL  
10 INSTITUTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

13 "TO LIMIT REMEDIATION AND TUTORIAL SERVICES AT TWO YEAR  
14 AND FOUR YEAR POST SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. No state supported two year or four-year post secondary  
19 educational institution shall hereafter provide tutorial or remediation  
20 services to any student who is a member of any of the athletic teams of the  
21 institution, except to the extent such tutorial and remediation services are  
22 provided to traditional first year students. Enrollment requirements for  
23 first year student athletes shall be the same as enrollment requirements for  
24 all other first year students at all state supported two year and four year  
25 post secondary educational institutions.

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.
