For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MERGE THE LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH THE
9 PORTION OF THE PULASKI SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT LOCATED
10 SOUTH OF THE ARKANSAS RIVER, AND TO MERGE THE NORTH LITTLE
11 ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH THE PORTION OF THE PULASKI
12 COUNTY SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT LOCATED NORTH OF THE
13 ARKANSAS RIVER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "TO MERGE LR SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH PORTION OF PULASKI CO.
17 SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AND NLR SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH
18 PORTION OF PULASKI CO. SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. The Little Rock School District is hereby merged with the
23 portion of the Pulaski County Special School District located south of the
24 Arkansas River. The board of directors of the Pulaski County Special School
25 District shall be the board for the merged school district until the election
26 of a new board of directors which shall consist of eleven (11) members to be
27 elected by zone. The boundaries of the zones shall be drawn by the Pulaski
28 County Board of Education within ninety (90) days after the effective date of
29 this act and shall be drawn in such manner as will comply with the Voting
30 Rights Act of 1973 and the principle of one-man one-vote.

32 SECTION 2. The North Little Rock School District is hereby merged into
33 that portion of the Pulaski County Special School District located north of
34 the Arkansas River. The board of directors of the North Little Rock School
35 District shall be the board for the merged school district until the election

1 of a new board of directors which shall consist of eleven (11) members to be
2 elected by zone. The boundaries of the zones shall be drawn by the Pulaski
3 County Board of Education within ninety (90) days after the effective date of
4 this act and shall be drawn in such manner as will comply with the Voting
5 Rights Act of 1973 and the principle of one-man one-vote.

7 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
8 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
9 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
15 act are declared to be severable.

16

17 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
18 hereby repealed.
