HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 3-3-202 TO
9 INCREASE THE RANGE OF PENALTIES FOR THE OFFENSE OF SELLING
10 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE
11 (21) YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO INCREASE THE RANGE OF PENALTIES FOR THE OFFENSE OF
15 SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF
16 TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 3-3-202 is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "§3-3-202. Knowingly furnishing to minor.

23 (a) It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to sell, give,
24 procure, or otherwise furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person under
25 twenty-one (21) years of age. However, this section shall not apply to the
26 serving of such to one's family or to the use of wine in any religious
27 ceremony or rite in any established church or religion.

28 (b) Any person violating this section shall, upon a first conviction,
29 be deemed guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. Upon a second conviction within
30 three (3) years, a person violating this section shall be deemed guilty of a
31 Class D felony."

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
