HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT ALLOWING THE USE OF BALLOTS USING ULTRAVIOLET INK
9 IN LIEU OF A BLACK OUT STICKER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "AN ACT ALLOWING THE USE OF BALLOTS USING ULTRAVIOLET INK
14 IN LIEU OF A BLACK OUT STICKER."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Any jurisdiction utilizing a system which counts ballots
19 electronically may at their discretion, substitute a serial number printed
20 with ultraviolet ink in lieu of the black out sticker.

22 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
23 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
24 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
27 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
28 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
29 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
30 act are declared to be severable.

32 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
33 hereby repealed.
