11 SERVICES FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,
12 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
16 APPROPRIATION-OFFICE OF FIRE PROTECTION
17 SERVICES."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.
22 There is hereby established for the Office of Emergency Services-
23 Office of Fire Protection Services for the 1993-95 biennium, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
25 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
26 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
27 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is
29 set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
31 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
32 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions
33 Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS -FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES. There
 13 is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Emergency Services-
 14 Office of Fire Protection Services, to be payable from the Fire
 15 Protection Premium Tax Fund, for personal services and operating
 16 expenses of the Office of Emergency Services-Office of Fire
 17 Protection Services for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995,

1 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of
2 funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the
3 appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for
4 the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the
5 State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
6 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other
8 fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
9 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
10 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
11 with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the
14 General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of
15 the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance
16 with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as
17 evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and
18 Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals
19 prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration,
20 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of
21 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which
22 relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general
25 and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987
26 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall
27 incorporate the same in the Code.

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29 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or
30 the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
31 invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or
32 applications of the Act which can be given effect without the
33 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
34 of this Act are declared to be severable.

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1 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in
2 conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

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4 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and
5 determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the
6 Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation
7 of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the
9 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act
10 are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the
11 Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act
12 beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
13 administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
15 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from
17 and after July 1, 1993.

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
