10 INITIATIVES PROPOSED AND IMPLEMENTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND
11 THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.

14 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH,
15 WELFARE AND LABOR TO MONITOR VARIOUS WELFARE REFORM
16 INITIATIVES.

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18 WHEREAS, the Division of Economic and Medical Services has requested a
19 waiver from the federal government to cap Aid to Families with Dependent
20 Children (AFDC) payments to recipients based on the number of children they
21 have ten (10) months after the new program takes effect; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Governor and the Department of Human Services are working
24 on a Managed Health Care System for Medicaid; and

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26 WHEREAS, there are other proposals under consideration which would
27 dramatically alter the current welfare program,

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29 NOW THEREFORE,

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
31 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

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33 THAT the Joint Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor be
34 requested to monitor the various welfare reform initiatives proposed and
35 implemented by the Governor and the Department of Human Services.

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AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this committee will make a progress report on the status of the welfare reform initiatives to the Eightieth (80th) General Assembly and make recommendations regarding any statutory provisions which might improve welfare services.
