19 WHEREAS, Congress has approved the extension of the Interstate 69
20 corridor from Memphis, Tennessee to Houston, Texas by way of Shreveport and
21 Bossier City, Louisiana but provided no funding for additional improvements or
22 studies; and

24 WHEREAS, a logical corridor for this route would traverse locations in
25 Eastern and South Arkansas,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

31 That the Arkansas General Assembly hereby supports the extension of this
32 proposed interstate highway through Arkansas and furthermore, supports the
33 efforts of the State Highway Commission in obtaining additional federal
34 funding for environmental, preliminary design, and other necessary studies
35 required for the extension of the route.
