17 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the state of  
18 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly  
19 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-  
20 thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

21 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Seventy-Ninth  
22 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this  
23 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will  
24 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session,

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL  
28 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

30 That the regular session of the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly of the  
31 state of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each  
32 house on April 2, 1993, at which time the 1993 regular session shall be  
33 adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is  
34 necessary to complete the business of the session.
