20 Scranton, Pennsylvania, was a star high school football player who went on to
21 play for the Penn State Nittany Lions; and

24 World War II as a member of the United States Navy while carrying on a long
25 distance romance with Dorothy Howell whom he married in 1942; and

27 WHEREAS, Hugh E. Rodham established a business in Chicago while he and
28 his wife, Dorothy raised their three children, Hillary, Hugh, and Tony in the
29 home they inhabited in Park Ridge, Illinois, for almost thirty-eight (38)
30 years before moving to Little Rock in 1987 to be near their only grandchild,
31 Chelsea Clinton.
