19 reared in Stamps of Lafayette County, Arkansas by her grandmother where she
20 received her formative education while attending Arkansas public schools; and

22 WHEREAS, Ms. Maya Angelou is best known for her best-selling book and
23 television movie, I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings, an autobiographical account
24 about her early life in a small Southern town with her brother and grandmother
25 in Stamps, Arkansas; and

27 WHEREAS, Ms. Maya Angelou is a wonderful and accomplished woman of the
28 world and a woman and artist who has given the world many wonderful gifts as
29 an author, poet, actress, singer, dancer, songwriter, teacher, playwright,
30 film director, and world traveler; and

32 WHEREAS, during Black History Month, it is fitting and proper to honor a
33 living black woman as one of the great voices in contemporary American
34 literature and a truly, remarkable Renaissance woman with Arkansas roots; and

2 Inauguration of Arkansas' own native-son, President Bill Clinton, where she
3 read her latest creative work, a poem, On the Pulse of the Morning,
