18 WHEREAS, the creation and expansion of successful small businesses in
19 Arkansas is a key to economic revitalization and job creation; and

21 WHEREAS, there is a direct correlation between entrepreneurship
22 training, job creation, and economic development; and

24 WHEREAS, any approach to furthering economic development in Arkansas
25 must include a systematic entrepreneurial education effort.

28 NOW THEREFORE,
29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32 THAT the Governor of the State of Arkansas is hereby respectfully
33 requested to form a coalition of representatives from the State Department of
34 Education, the Arkansas Human Development Corporation, the UALR Small Business
35 Development Center, the Small Business Administration, the Good Faith Fund,

1 the Arkansas Delta Council, and the Arkansas Rural Development Commission to
2 study ways of implementing youth and adult entrepreneurship education for all
3 Arkansans.

5 FURTHERMORE, upon the adoption of this resolution the Chief Clerk of the
6 House of Representatives shall transmit a copy of the same to the Governor.
