For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ARKANSAS
9 TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO PROVIDE COLLATERALIZED LOANS
10 TO QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF THE SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS TEACHER RETIREMENT
15 SYSTEM TO PROVIDE LOANS TO MEMBERS OF THE RETIREMENT
16 SYSTEM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. (a) The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher
21 Retirement System is authorized to provide loans to members of the system who
22 have at least twenty (20) years of credited service with the system.

23 (b) Any loan provided under this section shall be at the interest rate
24 recognized at the prevailing interest rate and set by the Board of Trustees.

25 (c) All loans shall be properly collateralized to the satisfaction of
26 the Board of Trustees.

27 (d) No loans shall exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) per
28 approved member.

29 (e) At no time shall the total number of loans provided under this
30 section exceed twenty five million dollars (\$25,000,000).

31 (f) The Board of Trustees is authorized to promulgate rules and
32 regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

33

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
