SENATE BILL 205

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-53-210 TO ALLOW THE
9 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO CHARGE ONE DOLLAR AND FIFTY CENTS
10 (\$1.50) PER PAGE FOR EACH COPY OF AN ACCIDENT REPORT; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 CENTS (\$1.50) PER PAGE FOR EACH COPY OF AN ACCIDENT
16 REPORT."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-53-210 is hereby amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "27-53-210. Copies - Fee.

23 (a) Photostatic or written copies of reports and records may be
24 obtained from the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police, or from
25 his duly designated assistants, by any person who shall request the department
26 for them in writing.

27 (b) (1) In order to partially reimburse the department for the cost of
28 making photostatic or written copies of motor vehicle accident reports and of
29 records of traffic violations, there shall be charged a fee of *ten dollars*
30 *(\$10.00) for each copy of a basic accident report and one dollar and fifty*
31 *cents (\$1.50) per page for each copy of supplemental report.*

32 (2) All funds collected under this subsection shall immediately be paid
33 over by the department to the State Treasurer and shall be credited by him as
34 a special revenue to the State Police Fund."

35

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
