17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Beginning January 1, 1994 the clerk-secretary of the Ninth
20 Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West shall receive an annual salary of
21 seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000). Beginning January 1, 1995 and for each
22 year thereafter the clerk-secretary shall receive an annual salary of eighteen
23 thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500). The salaries and expenses shall be
24 paid by each county comprising the Ninth Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West
25 with the proportion to be paid by each county to be determined by the judge of
26 the Circuit with consideration of the assessed value of all real and personal
27 property in each county, the population of each county, and the case load of
28 the court in each county. The salary provided for in this act shall be paid
29 by each county as herein specified in equal monthly payments on the first day
30 of each month.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Beginning January 1, 1994 the clerk-secretary of the Ninth Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West shall receive an annual salary of seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000). Beginning January 1, 1995 and for each year thereafter the clerk-secretary shall receive an annual salary of eighteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500). The salaries and expenses shall be paid by each county comprising the Ninth Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit West with the proportion to be paid by each county to be determined by the judge of the Circuit with consideration of the assessed value of all real and personal property in each county, the population of each county, and the case load of the court in each county. The salary provided for in this act shall be paid by each county as herein specified in equal monthly payments on the first day of each month.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
