SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE HIGHWAY AND
9 TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS
10 WHEREBY RAILROAD CARS MUST HAVE REFLECTIVE PAINT OR
11 REFLECTIVE SIGNS ON EACH SIDE TO BE MORE VISIBLE AT
12 RAILROAD CROSSINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "REQUIRING THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO PROMULGATE
15 REGULATIONS WHEREBY SIDES OF RAILROAD CARS SHALL HAVE
16 REFLECTIVE PAINT."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. The State Highway and Transportation Department shall
22 promulgate rules and regulations to require that by January 1, 1994, all
23 railroad cars must have reflective paint or reflective signs on each side in
24 order to be more visible at railroad crossings.

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29
30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
