SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-57-204 (d) TO EXTEND
9 FROM JULY 1, 1993 THROUGH JULY 1, 1995, THE PERMIT FEE
10 ESTABLISHED BY THAT SUBSECTION FOR FOOD SERVICE
11 ESTABLISHMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO EXTEND FROM JULY 1, 1993, THROUGH JULY 1, 1995, THE
15 PERMIT FEE ESTABLISHED FOR FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of Arkansas Code 20-57-204 is hereby amended
20 to read as follows:

21 "(d) Each distinctively separate food establishment type and class as
22 defined in §§ 20-57-201 - 20-57-205 shall be required to procure a permit for
23 that type or class per each location not to exceed a total of seventy-five
24 dollars (\$75.00). On and after July 1, 1995, the fee provisions as set forth
25 in this subsection shall be null and void and any food service establishment
26 may obtain a food service permit by meeting the minimum requirements
27 established by the applicable rules and regulations."

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
