25	is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said

28	Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its

SECTION 5. ALLOCATION RESTRICTION. Of the amounts allocated in Section 2 4 hereof, it is the intent of the General Assembly that such amounts are to be 3 the maximum expended in the applicable fiscal year from the funds as 4 appropriated in Section 3 hereof for the benefit of the appropriate program so 5 enumerated. Provided, however, that in the event that unforeseen 6 circumstances occur in either fiscal year that would necessitate a transfer of 7 the maximum allocation provided in Section 4, hereof from one or more programs 8 to another program or programs as enumerated in said Section 4, the Department 9 shall make its request known, and the reasons thereof, to the Budget Division, 10 Department of Finance and Administration, in such form and detail as may be 11 required by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and if approved, such 12 transfer approval shall be transmitted to the Fiscal and Tax Research Division 13 of the Bureau of Legislative Research, who shall make a report of the 14 transfers and the reasons thereof to the Arkansas Legislative Council at least 15 quarterly. Further provided, that nothing in this Section shall be construed 16 in such a manner as to allow a transfer between any items as set out in 17 Section 3 hereof, nor that any transfer request of allocations be granted 18 unless needed, as determined by the Department of Finance and Administration, 19 has been proven to the satisfaction of said Department of Finance and 20 Administration. 22 SECTION 6. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby authorized, for the

The Department of Parks and 17 Tourism is hereby authorized to purchase "Revenue Producing Equipment" such as 18 boats, golf carts, etc., from the "Resale Purchase" line item. The resale 19 purchase line item or any cash funds shall not be used to purchase heavy 20 construction equipment. 21 — 22 SECTION 32. EXTRA HELP RESTRICTION. No employee of the Parks Division 23 of the Department of Parks and Tourism who is employed as "Extra Help" may 24 receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum annual 25 salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et 26 seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for a period 27 of time to exceed eighteen hundred hours (1800) in any single fiscal year. 28 29 SECTION 33. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in Section 3 30 of this Act for Parks and Museums System Deferred Maintenance shall be 31 expended only after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council 32 for a deferred maintenance program for the Park System. The funds provided 33 will be used for repair and upkeep of parks and museum facilities or the Ozark

34 Folk Center that have been deferred due to lack of funds in the individual

35 budgets of the parks and museums or of the Ozark Folk Center.

1 SECTION 34. CASH PRIZES. REGIONAL TOURIST PROMOTION AGENCY GRANT RESTRICTION. 28 the amount appropriated in Item (06) of Section 3 for "Tourist Promotion", no 29 funds shall be expended for grants until such time as the grantee organization 30 shall show proof of expenditures from non-state funds an amount equal to

33 SECTION 39. PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS. The Department of Parks and Tourism 34 is hereby authorized to purchase from "Maintenance and General Operations" 35 appropriations provided by this Act, uniforms for Parks personnel, Museum

1 Services personnel, Tourist Information Center personnel, and uniforms and 2 blazers to be used by employees of the Department of Parks and Tourism who are 3 staffing sports shows, travel shows and other special promotional programs and 4 special theme costumes or uniforms for state parks. Provided further, that 5 any clothing purchased under the provisions stated in this section shall 6 remain the property of the Department of Parks and Tourism and shall be 7 surrendered upon request of the Department or upon termination of employment 8 of the individual to whom the clothing was issued. 9 SECTION 40. SECTION 48. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 12 13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 18 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 19 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21

22 SECTION 49. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 24 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 25 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31 SECTION 50. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 32 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the 33 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 51. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 35

	application thereof to any person of circumstance is held invalid, such
2	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
3	can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
4	end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
5	
6	SECTION 52. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
7	with this Act are hereby repealed.
8	
9	SECTION 53. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
10	Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
11	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
12	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
13	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
16	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
