## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-93-404 (F) TO AUTHORIZE  
9 THE CHANGING OF THE FEE FOR RE-EXAMINATION FOR A LICENSE  
10 TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

14 "TO AUTHORIZE THE CHARGING OF FEE FOR RE-EXAMINATION FOR A  
15 LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-93-404(f) is amended to read as follows:

20 "17-93-404. Examinations.

21 (f) If an applicant fails to meet the minimum grade requirements in his  
22 examination, he may be reexamined upon a filing of a new application and the  
23 payment of the required fee as stated in the rules and regulations of the  
24 board and payment of the required fee for the administration and grading of  
25 the examination."

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly that it is necessary to allow applicants who have failed an examination for licensure to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas to be able to retake the examination upon the payment of the required costs and fees for the examination; therefore, immediate effect should be given to this measure and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
