SENATE BILL 393

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
20 Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following
21 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
22 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
23 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
24 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
25 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
29 successor.

7 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
9 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
10 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary
11 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
12 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,
13 or this act for the appropriate classification.

15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CODE REVISION FUND. There is hereby
16 appropriated, to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the
17 Code Revision Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
18 Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30,
19 1995, the following:

35 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the

1 Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the State General
2 Services Fund Account, for personal services of the Arkansas Code Revision
3 Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

11 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
12 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
14 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
15 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
16 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
17 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
19 with in disbursement of said funds.

20

21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
23 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
28 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29

30 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
35 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall

1 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
2 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
3 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
6 this Act are hereby repealed.

7

8 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
9 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
10 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
11 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
