SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-27-1102 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 THE DIRECTOR OF LABOR MAY CHARGE A FEE NOT TO EXCEED
10 THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30.00) FOR CERTIFYING BLASTERS; TO AMEND
11 ARKANSAS CODE 19-6-401 AND 19-5-302(8) TO CLASSIFY SUCH
12 FEES AS SPECIAL REVENUES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FUND
13 ACCOUNT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE FEES BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-27-1102 is hereby amended by adding a new
21 subsection to read as follows:

22 "(d) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Labor is authorized to
23 establish by regulation fees for certifying individuals as qualified to
24 perform blasting in Arkansas. Such fees shall not exceed the sum of thirty
25 dollars (\$30.00) per applicant."

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-6-301 is hereby amended by adding a new
28 subsection to read as follows:

29 "Fees for certifying blasters, §20-27-1102,"

31 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(8) is hereby amended to read as
32 follows:

33 "(8) (A) DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FUND ACCOUNT. The Department of Labor Fund
34 Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required
35 by the Department of Labor in carrying out those powers, functions, and duties

1 imposed by law upon the Labor Commissioner or the Labor Department or upon the
2 State Mine Inspector as set out in §11-7-201 et seq., or any other duties that
3 may be imposed by law upon the department which was transferred to the
4 department by § 25-12-101.

5 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

6 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

7 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the
8 department programs operating from the account;

9 (iii) Those special revenues as set out in subdivision (25) of §
10 19-6-301 of Revenue Classification Law and section 2 of this act; and

11 (iv) Such other funds as may be provided by law including federal
12 reimbursement received on account of eligible expenditures by the various
13 programs of the Department of Labor operating from and having appropriations
14 made payable from the Account."

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16 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
18 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 5. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
24 act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 6. All laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

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
