**SENATE BILL 477**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-6-203 (g) TO PROHIBIT  
9 CANDIDATES FOR CERTAIN OFFICES AND CERTAIN EXPLORATORY  
10 COMMITTEES FROM ACCEPTING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS DURING  
11 THE PERIOD BEGINNING THIRTY (30) DAYS BEFORE AND ENDING  
12 THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER ANY REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL  
13 ASSEMBLY OR DURING ANY SPECIAL SESSION; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

17 "AN ACT PROHIBITING CANDIDATES FOR CERTAIN OFFICES AND  
18 CERTAIN EXPLORATORY COMMITTEES FROM ACCEPTING CAMPAIGN  
19 CONTRIBUTIONS DURING CERTAIN PERIODS."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-6-203 (g) is amended to read as follows:

24 "(g) It shall be unlawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor,  
25 Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Auditor of State, Attorney General,  
26 Commissioner of State Lands, members of the General Assembly, a candidate for  
27 any such office, or an exploratory committee for the candidacy of any person  
28 to any such office to accept a contribution during the period beginning thirty  
29 (30) days before and ending thirty (30) days after any regular session of the  
30 General Assembly or during any special session of the General Assembly. During  
31 such periods of time, it shall be unlawful for any person to promise a  
32 contribution to the aforementioned elected officials, candidates, and  
33 exploratory committees."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.

12

13 SECTION 5. *The provisions of this act shall be effective on January 1,*  
14 *1994.*
