# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-28-703 REGARDING THE  
9 BOOT CAMP PROGRAM OF THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF  
10 CORRECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM SIXTY-DAY BOOT CAMP PROGRAM."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-28-703 is amended to read as follows:  
18 "12-28-703. Authorization.

19 The Arkansas Board of Correction shall develop and implement a boot camp  
20 program designed to reduce the inmate population by diverting eligible  
21 offenders from long-term incarceration. This diversion shall involve  
22 successful completion of a minimum of a sixty-day program of intensive  
23 behavior modification in an arduous, physically demanding, military-like  
24 environment, otherwise known as a boot camp."

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
34 act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
