7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO INSTITUTE PROCEDURES
9 AND GUIDELINES FOR ALLOWING EMPLOYEES TO VOLUNTEER THEIR
10 SERVICES TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND VO-TECH SCHOOLS DURING
11 WORKING HOURS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 **Subtitle**

14 "STATE AGENCIES TO ALLOW EMPLOYEES TO VOLUNTEER THEIR
15 SERVICES TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND VO-TECH SCHOOLS DURING
16 WORKING HOURS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Every state agency, board, commission, office and
21 institution is hereby directed to institute a program and establish guidelines
22 whereby their employees may, during working hours and without loss of pay,
23 provide voluntary services at public elementary or secondary schools or
24 vocational-technical schools to assist in the improvement of the educational
25 program of the institutions. No public elementary or secondary school or
26 vocational-technical school shall compensate the state employees for such
27 voluntary services.

28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
