# A Bill

**SENATE BILL 55**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURE FOR NOTIFICATION TO DFA  
WHEN MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE IS CANCELED; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

"TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURE FOR NOTIFICATION TO DFA WHEN MOTOR  
VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE IS CANCELED."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. When any policy of motor vehicle liability insurance required by Arkansas Code 27-22-101 et seq is canceled or expires, the insurer shall notify the Department of Finance and Administration within twenty (20) calendar days after the policy is canceled or expires. A mechanical photo copy of a cancellation notice will be sufficient for notice to the Department of Finance and Administration. Within ten (10) calendar days after receiving the notice the Department of Finance and Administration shall notify the owner of the motor vehicle that his operators\_ license will be revoked if he does not, within thirty (30) calendar days, furnish proof of insurance in compliance with Arkansas Code 27-22-101 et seq or a certificate of self-insurance pursuant to Arkansas Code 27-19-107. "Expires" refers to the date after which continuous coverage cannot be provided under the Motor Vehicle Liability insurance policy even if payment of the premium is received by the Insurer.*

*SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

*SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.*

*SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.*
