SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 20-25-105 TO CHANGE THE
9 APPOINTMENT PROCEDURE FOR MEMBERS OF THE MANUFACTURED HOME
10 COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO CHANGE THE APPOINTMENT PROCEDURE FOR MEMBERS OF THE
14 MANUFACTURED HOME COMMISSION."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-25-105 is amended to read as follows:

19 "20-25-105. Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission - Creation - Members.

20 (a) (1) There is created the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission
21 consisting of ten (10) members. Members shall be appointed by the Governor, to
22 be confirmed by the Senate, and appointments shall be made in such a manner as
23 to result in at least one (1) member residing in each congressional district
24 as the congressional districts now and hereafter exist. The members shall be
25 representative of the following interests:

26 (A) Four (4) members shall be active in the manufactured
27 home industry; and

28 (B) Five (5) members shall be from the public at large; and

29 (C) One (1) member shall be sixty (60) years of age or
30 older and represent the elderly. He shall not be actively engaged in or
31 retired from the industry of manufactured homes.

32 (2) Appointments of those active in the manufactured home
33 industry shall be made by the Governor from a list of three (3) names
34 submitted to him by the trade association for each appointment.

35 (3) Each member shall be appointed for a five-year term except

1 that a person appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve only the unexpired
2 portion of the term. Each member's term shall extend until his successor is
3 appointed and qualified.

4 (4) The members shall not receive compensation for their services
5 as members but shall receive reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred in
6 connection with the performance of their duties as commission members.

7 (5) Membership on the commission shall not constitute holding a
8 public office, and no member shall be disqualified from holding any public
9 office or employment by reason of membership on the commission; nor shall the
10 member forfeit such office or employment by reason of his appointment
11 hereunder, notwithstanding any law to the contrary.

12 (b) A chairman and vice-chairman shall be elected by the commission to
13 serve two (2) years."

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15 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
23 act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
26 hereby repealed.

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
