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18 WHEREAS, every Arkansas school student should have the opportunity to  
19 learn the history of Arkansas; and

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21 WHEREAS, Arkansas has a long and distinctive history; and

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23 WHEREAS, Arkansas historians have recently published a series of  
24 textbooks on the state; and

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26 WHEREAS, the State Board of Education recently adopted a standard  
27 requiring a one (1) semester course on Arkansas history at the seventh (7th)  
28 or eighth (8th) grade levels,

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31 NOW THEREFORE,

32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
33 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

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35 THAT the Joint Interim Committee on Education monitor the implementation

1 of the above-referenced Arkansas history educational standard; and

2           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said committee issue a report on this  
3 important matter by July 1, 1994; and

4           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the General Assembly urge the  
5 Director and the staff of the Arkansas Department of Education to work  
6 diligently to ensure that the Arkansas history curriculum is implemented  
7 fully.

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
