29 having maintained a remarkable commitment to providing first-rate health care;

31 WHEREAS, Ms. Weixelman's unrelenting dedication to her work challenges
32 all health care professionals to reach for new heights in the delivery of

35 WHEREAS, Ms. Weixelman is one of the first recipients of the Gentle

1 Giant in Medicine Award bestowed by G. D. Searle & Co. upon deserving health
2 care professionals; and

5 publicly recognize and commend Ms. Bernie Weixelman's exemplary career in
6 nursing and thank her for her contribution to the health care profession in
