12 SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS

15 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the state of  
16 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly  
17 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-  
18 thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

19 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Seventy-Ninth  
20 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this  
21 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will  
22 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session,

24 NOW THEREFORE,

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
26 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

28 That the regular session of the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly of the  
29 state of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each  
30 house on April 2, 1993, at which time the 1993 regular session shall be  
31 adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is  
32 necessary to complete the business of the session.
