14 COMMENDING MR. RON HARROD FOR HIS TEN YEARS OF SERVICE ON
15 THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

17 WHEREAS, the ten-year term of Mr. Ron Harrod on the Arkansas Highway and
18 Transportation Commission will expire in January 1993; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Harrod has served the Highway and Transportation Commission
21 most recently as its chairman and has served in that capacity in an exemplary
22 manner; and

24 WHEREAS, during Mr. Harrod_s tenure on the Commission, there have been
25 3,289 highway projects that have been undertaken at a cost of 2.045 billion
26 dollars, and these expenditures are very important to the Arkansas economy
27 because for every million dollars spent for highway construction, about fifty
28 jobs are created; and

30 WHEREAS, over 9,000 miles of roads in Arkansas have been constructed and
31 improved, and 930 bridges have been replaced and improved during Mr. Harrod_s
32 membership on the Commission; and

34 WHEREAS, during Mr. Harrod_s tenure, over 900 million dollars have been
35 spent on state road maintenance projects; and

WHEREAS, when Mr. Harrod joined the Commission in January 1983, there were 654 miles of unpaved highways in Arkansas, and currently there are only 129 miles of unpaved highways remaining in this State; and

WHEREAS, since 1983, six bridges have been built replacing existing ferry systems; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly publicly recognize and commend the outstanding service Mr. Harrod has provided to the people of this State during his ten years on the Highway and Transportation Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
