16 WHEREAS, the Angel Flight program of Arkansas Children_s Hospital
17 provides safe and fast transportation of critically injured and ill children;

20 WHEREAS, during January and February of 1993, the Angel Flight crews
21 transported 257 critically injured or ill children, from newborn infants to
22 teenage children; and

24 WHEREAS, both January and February were record months for the number of
25 children transported and the month of March is on pace as another record
26 month; and

28 WHEREAS, there is a great demand for the services of the two helicopters
29 of Angel Flights and, in order to maintain a crew at all times and to properly
30 service and maintain the program, a team of forty-five persons, many of whom
31 are on call at all times, is required; and

33 WHEREAS, the Angel Flight crews are called upon day and night, despite
34 difficult weather conditions and difficult landing situations, to save the
35 life of a child; and
