15 WHEREAS, the city of Piggott, Arkansas, has celebrated the Fourth of
16 July holiday with a community picnic annually for the past seventy years; and

17 WHEREAS, during the last sixteen years, President Clinton has

18 participated in the Piggott Fourth of July celebration no less than twelve
19 times; and

20 WHEREAS, President Clinton has stated on various occasions that he
21 intends to keep in touch with the people of his native state; and

22 WHEREAS, since the annual Piggott Fourth of July celebration is a
23 homecoming event, it attracts numerous people from around the United States
24 and particularly from the states that neighbor northeast Arkansas; and

25 WHEREAS, if President Clinton attends the celebration, it is anticipated
26 that at least 50,000 people will attend; and

27 WHEREAS, if President Clinton chooses to make a national policy speech
28 at the event, the attention of millions of media listeners will be focused on
29 our state,
