- 34 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
- 35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
- 36 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2	SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
3	application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
4	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
5	can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
6	end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
7	
8	SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
9	with this Act are hereby repealed.
10	
11	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined that
12	the Eighty-First General Assembly meeting in Regular Session has considered
13	and enacted appropriations for construction projects and other programs to be
14	financed from the accumulated surplus and reserve funds available in the State
15	Treasury; that the total of the enacted appropriations exceed the estimated
16	available funds and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to
17	establish a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of
18	priority for the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is
19	hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate
20	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force
21	and effect from and after its passage and approval. If the bill is neither
22	approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the

23 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. 24 If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall

25 become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
