9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR PROJECTS
10 IN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
11 GOVERNOR; TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE CHIEF FISCAL
12 OFFICER OF THE STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Improvement
22 Distribution Act of 1997".
23

24 SECTION 2. There is hereby created and established on the books of the
25 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,
26 the "81st Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",
27 into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as
28 hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the
29 manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in
30 this Act to be financed from said account.

31 Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter
32 as is practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "81st
33 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon
34 certification of the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
35 the following:
36

1 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the
2 "General Improvement Fund" which are not required to finance projects to be
3 financed therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 81st General
4 Assembly, or which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for financing
5 from the "General Improvement Fund" by the 81st General Assembly;

6 (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining in the "General
7 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto during the 1995-
8 97 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance enactments of the 81st
9 General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 1997 and after providing for
10 the transfer to the Balanced Budget Reserve Fund, as may be authorized by law;
11 and

12 (c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in
13 this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 1997, and ending June
14 30, 1999, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

15 (1) Arkansas Code §27-70-204 for distributing interest income
16 earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and
17 Transportation Department Fund",

18 (2) Arkansas Code §15-41-110 for distributing interest earned
19 from investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund",

20 (3) Arkansas Code §15-5-422 for the first two million dollars
21 (\$2,000,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State
22 Treasurer as authorized for the Correction Facilities Construction Fund, and

23 (4) Arkansas Code §20-78-504 for the next one hundred thousand
24 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State
25 Treasurer for the Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund,
26 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty
27 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities
28 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "81st Session Projects Account" fifty percent
29 (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities Reserve
30 Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to provide
31 financing to the "81st Session Projects Account", until there has been
32 credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for such
33 purposes will finance each of the projects or purposes hereinafter enumerated.
34

35 SECTION 3. (A) From the monies accruing to the benefit of the "81st
36 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund" as authorized by

1 Section 2 of this Act, the Governor may direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
2 State to effectuate an allocation of monies for financing certain
3 appropriation and transfers of monies as authorized by the 81st General
4 Assembly as follows:

5 In the event all of the allocations of monies for any of the
6 purposes or projects listed in subsection (A) of this section cannot be made
7 due to the inadequacy of required matching monies, the Governor is hereby
8 authorized to defer to a later time such allocations and then proceed to
9 authorize allocations of monies in accordance with the provisions of paragraph
10 (B) of this Section. Such allocations of monies previously deferred, may be
11 authorized by the Governor at any time after complying with the matching
12 requirements.

13

14 (B) After financing is provided for the purposes and projects
15 enumerated in Subsection (A) herein; from the remaining monies accruing to the
16 benefit of the "81st Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement
17 Fund" as authorized by Section 2 of this Act, the Governor may direct the
18 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to effectuate an allocation of monies for
19 the following purposes:

23 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which
24 allocations are provided in Subsection (A) of Section 3 of this Act, the
25 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same
26 time he shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in
27 Subsection (A) of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made
28 available, and shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and
29 the priorities to be followed in providing funds for each such project.

30 (B) In the event sufficient monies are not available or are estimated
31 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which
32 allocations are provided in Subsection (B) of Section 3 of this Act, the
33 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same
34 time shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in
35 Subsection (B) of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made
36 available, and shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and

1 the priorities to be followed in providing funds for each such project.

2 (C) In the event sufficient monies are not available or are estimated
3 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which
4 allocations are provided in Subsection (C) of Section 3 of this Act, the
5 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same
6 time notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in Subsection (C)
7 of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made available, and
8 shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and the priorities to
9 be followed in providing funds for each such project.

11 SECTION 5. Any enactment of the 81st General Assembly appropriating or
12 allocating funds to be payable from the "General Improvement Fund", for which
13 a specific allocation of funds is specifically authorized in this Act, shall
14 be deemed to be payable from the "81st Session Projects Account" within the
15 "General Improvement Fund" unless a specific intent is otherwise provided by
16 law. Any enactment of the 81st General Assembly appropriating funds payable
17 from the General Improvement Fund which is not enumerated in this Act shall
18 not be financed from monies accruing to the 81st Session Projects Account.
19 Provided that monies reappropriated by the 81st General Assembly for projects
20 for which appropriations were made by the 80th General Assembly, which are not
21 enumerated in this Act and which are made payable from the "General
22 Improvement Fund", shall be payable from the "80th Session Projects Account"
23 of the "General Improvement Fund" and allowances shall be made therefore in
24 arriving at the uncommitted and unobligated balance of monies in the "General
25 Improvement Fund" before making transfers therefrom to the "81st Session
26 Projects Account", as authorized by this Act.

27

28 SECTION 6. Distribution of funds for constructing and equipping the
29 radiation therapy institutes specified herein, shall be contingent upon the
30 provision of matching funds, including those monies previously raised but not
31 previously used to match state funds, on a dollar by dollar basis on behalf of
32 each such radiation therapy institute.

33

34 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
36 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined that the Eighty-First General Assembly meeting in Regular Session has considered and enacted appropriations for construction projects and other programs to be financed from the accumulated surplus and reserve funds available in the State Treasury; that the total of the enacted appropriations exceed the estimated available funds and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to establish a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of priority for the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
