All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature 1 2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 4 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 5 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 8 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this 9 act are declared to be severable. 10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 11 12 hereby repealed. 13 Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the 14 SECTION 5. 15 Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that current law 16 requires State Highway Department employees to be members of the Highway 17 Employees' Retirement System even if they are retired from another state-18 supported retirement system; that this violates a longstanding policy of 19 prohibiting persons from earning service credit in two (2) state-supported 20 retirement systems; and the law should be changed to limit the eligibility for 21 double service credit to only those Highway employees' currently eligible and 22 required to be members.
